- 3. Least number of points given up in the first half of all games.

Games will consist of two 20-minute halves with a running clock except for the last two minutes of each half. A complete set of rules for the tournament is attached.

JUNIOR WARHAWK TOURNAMENT RULES

<u>Playing Time</u>: 20-minute halves with a running clock except for the last two

minutes of each half. One hour is allowed for each game. Any game that goes over the hour time limit will be cut short if there is

a 10+ point margin.

Warm Ups: Five minute warm ups. Teams should stretch before the game and

be ready to play.

<u>Half Time</u>: Three minutes.

Offense: Three point shots are allowed. Full size balls for 7th and 8th grade,

28.5 for 5th and 6th.

<u>Defense</u>: Any defense is allowed for grades 6th, 7th and 8th. The 5th grade

may play half court man-to-man defense only. The 5th grade may

trap but only out of man-to-man defense

Pressing: Pressing for 6th, 7th and 8th grade is allowed unless the team is up

by 15 points. A full court man-to-man defense will be allowed during the last two minutes of each half for 5th grade teams, unless

the team is ahead by 15 or more points.

<u>Time Outs</u>: Two full time outs per half. Extra time outs do not carry over into

the other half or overtime. One time out per overtime.

Scoring: The leading team's score will be frozen on the scoreboard when

they are ahead by 20 or more points, but the official score will still

be kept in the scorebook.

Overtime: Two minutes with a regular clock.

<u>Technical Fouls:</u> Sportsmanship technical is automatic two points plus possession of

the ball is awarded to the opponent. All other technical fouls are two free throws and possession is awarded to the opponent. Two technical fouls during the whole tournament will result in that

player/coach's disqualification from the tournament.

Sportsmanship: Good sportsmanship is expected from all players, coaches, and

fans. Foul language will not be tolerated. Referees and tournament personnel may remove anyone from the site of competition if they feel it is necessary. Teams may also be disqualified from the

<u>Scorekeepers</u>: Tournament personnel will run the clock and be the official

scorekeeper. Each team will be asked to provide a person to do a

scorebook for their team to verify the scoreboard.

1. Tournament record, 2. Head to Head, 3. Least points allowed in
